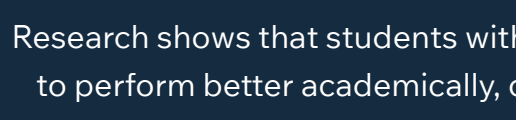

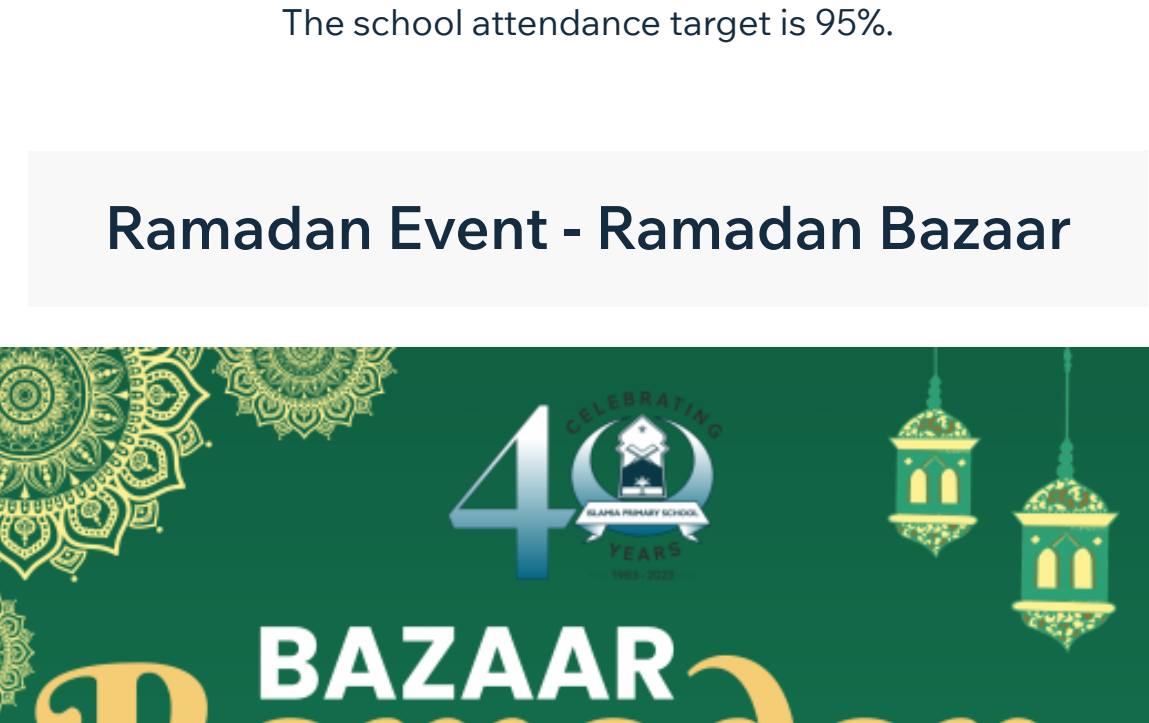
Attendance Matters!

The Prophet (ﷺ) taught the following dua for Layla t'al Qadr to Aisha (R.A.),

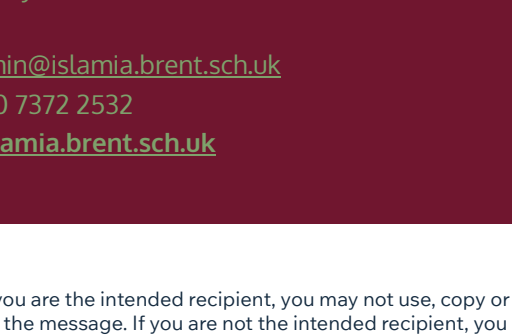

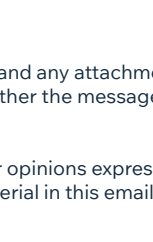
