Headteacher's Message

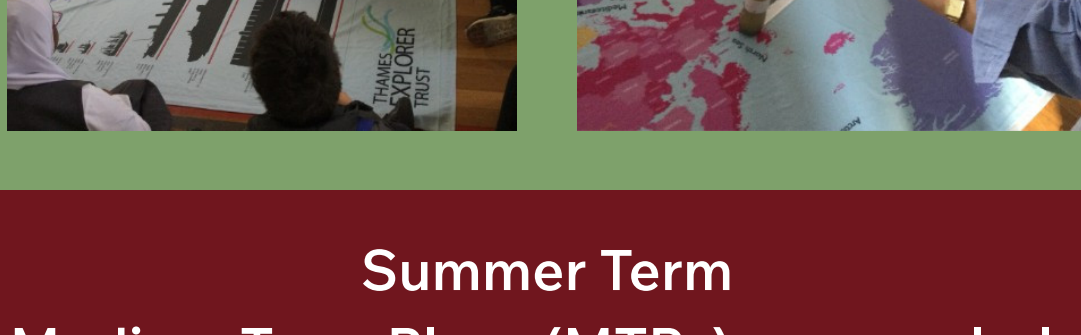

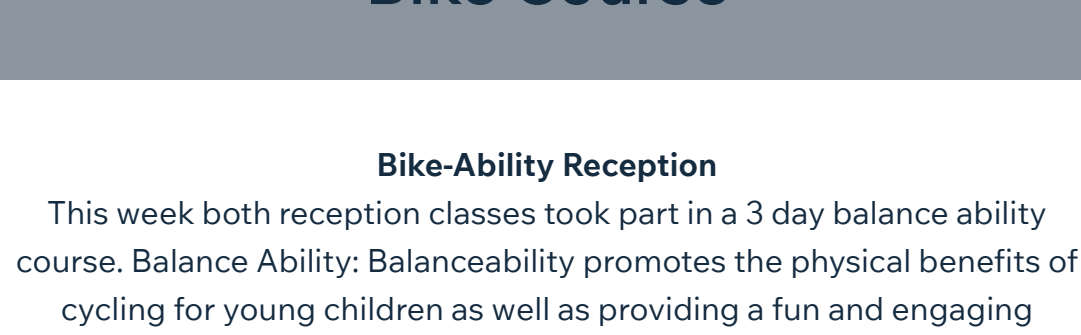

Thames Water Workshop

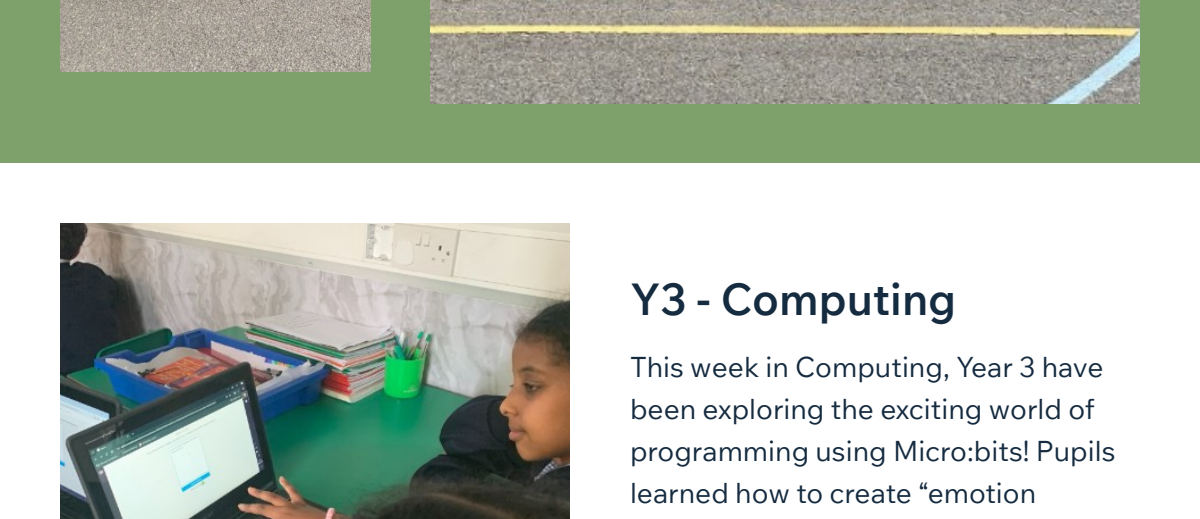

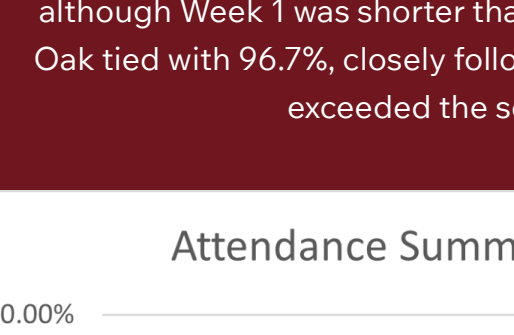


Y3 - Computing

This week in Computing, Year 3 have been exploring the exciting world of programming using Micro:bits! Pupils learned how to create "emotion badges" by coding facial expressions that represent different feelings. It's been a fantastic introduction to digital creativity and logical thinking!

Year 2 – PE:Year 2 have kicked off a brand new unit in football! The children practised dribbling and learned how to control the ball using different parts of their bodies. It was a fun and active session that helped develop coordination and control.

What can you do at home to encourage Islamic Tabiyyah?

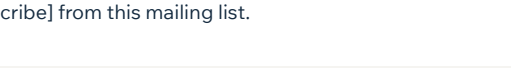
