Curriculum Corner

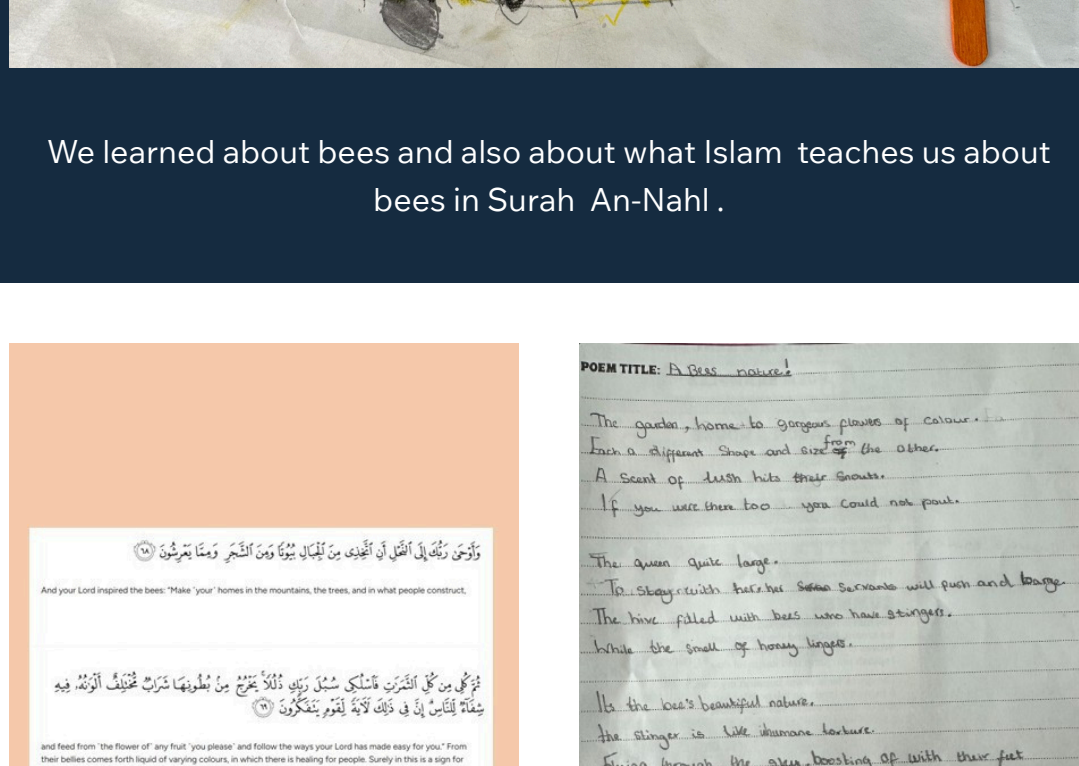
Jack and the Beanstalk was our story this week in Reception Class!
