Headteacher's Message

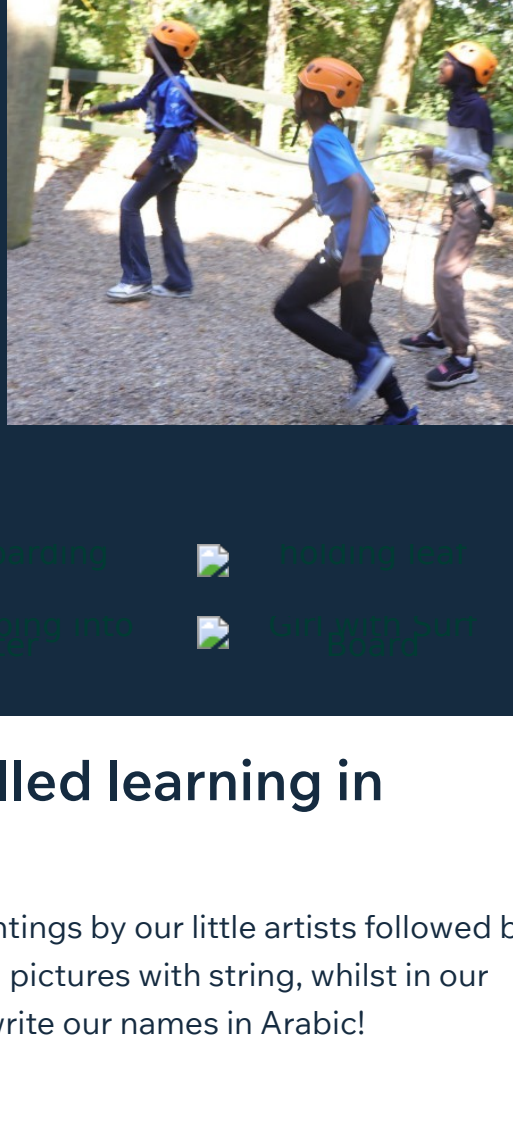
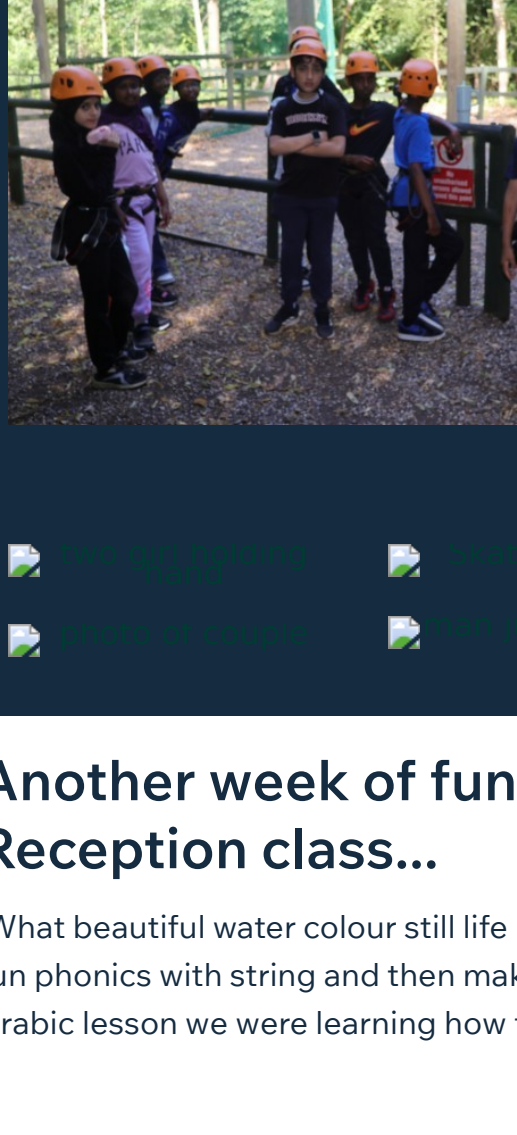

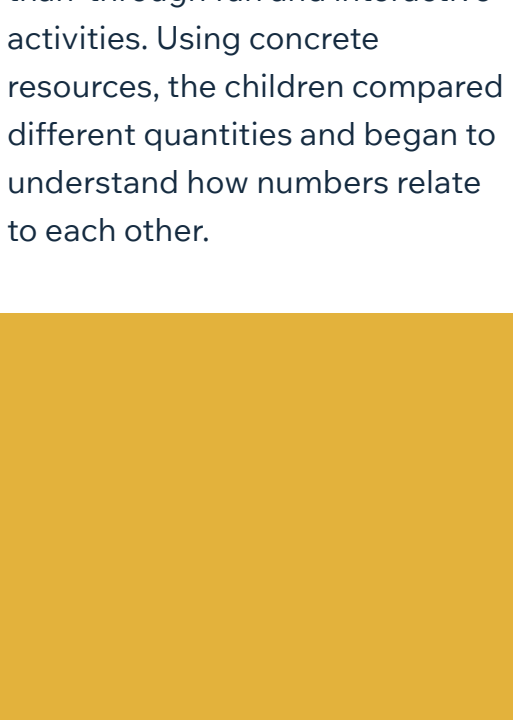
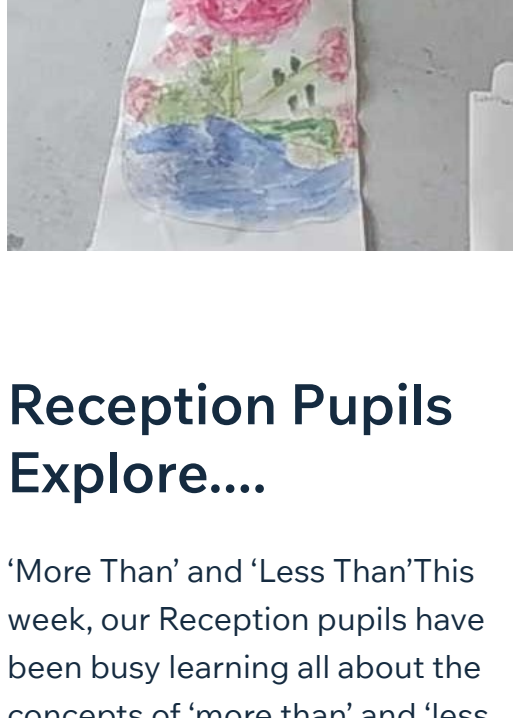
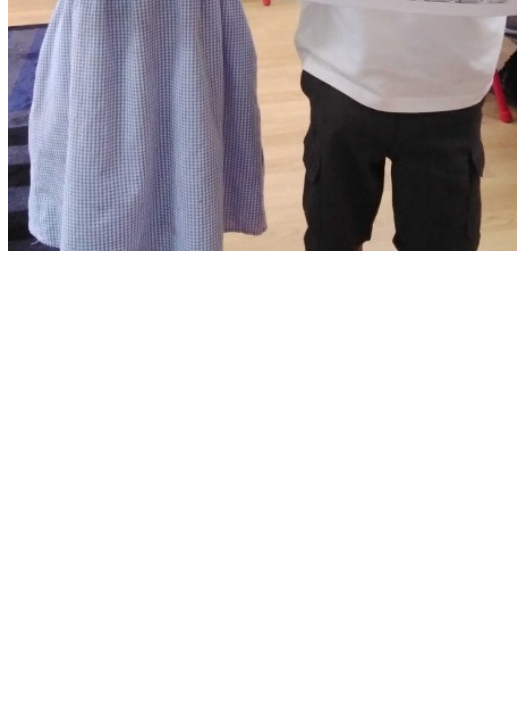
Curriculum Corner

Jumuah Reminder

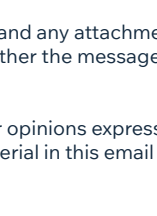
Muharram is a sacred month in Islam...
