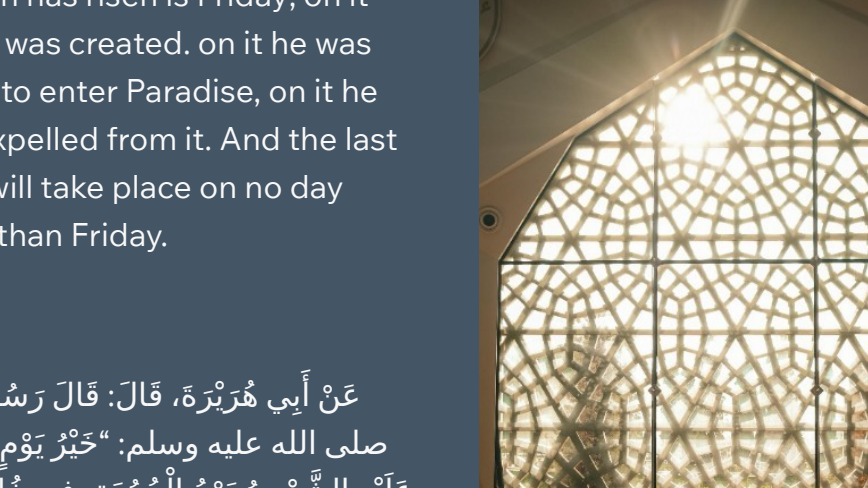

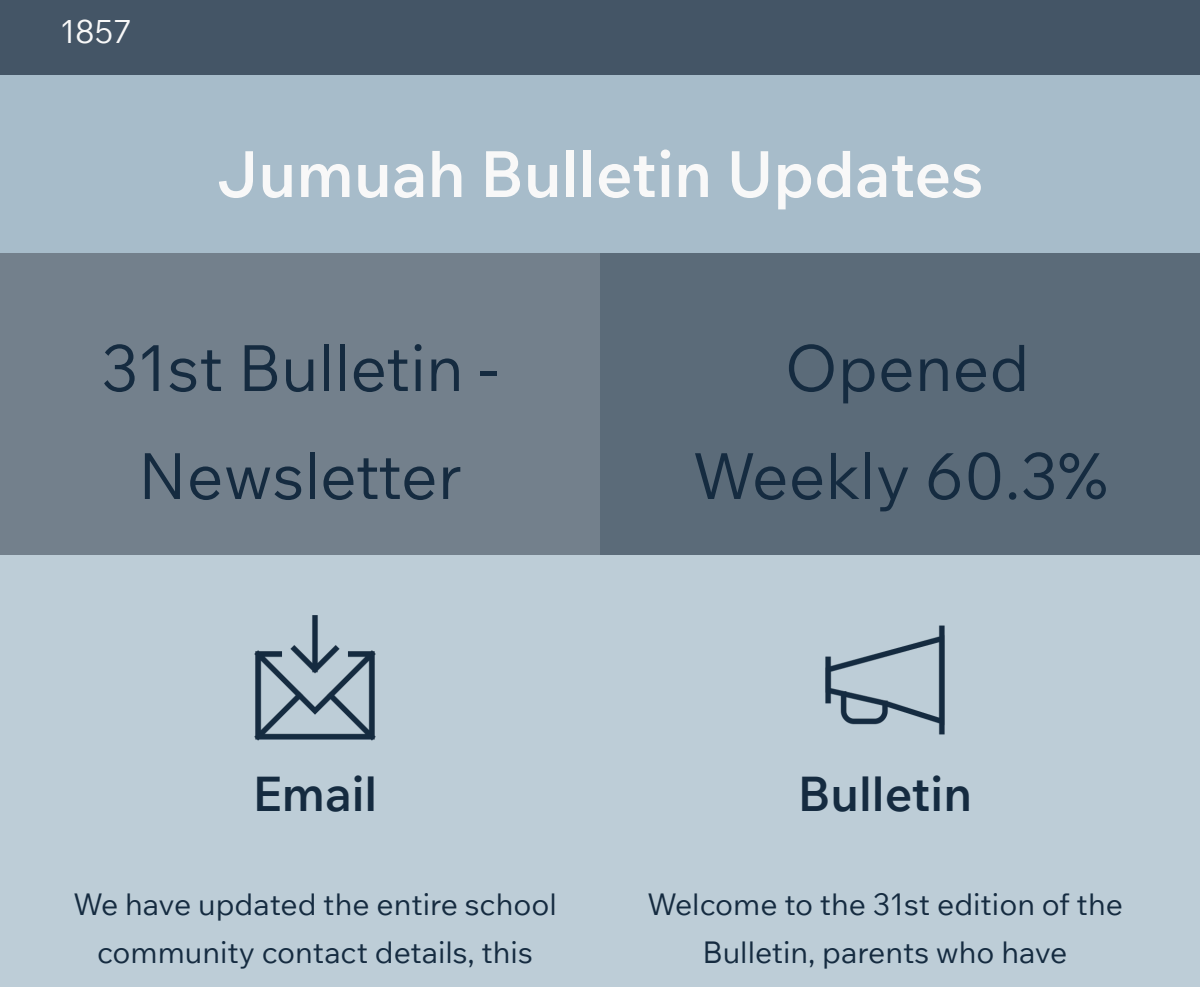

This term, we will be celebrating attendance in **Key Stage Phase Assemblies** and recognising the achievement of the winning classes week by week.

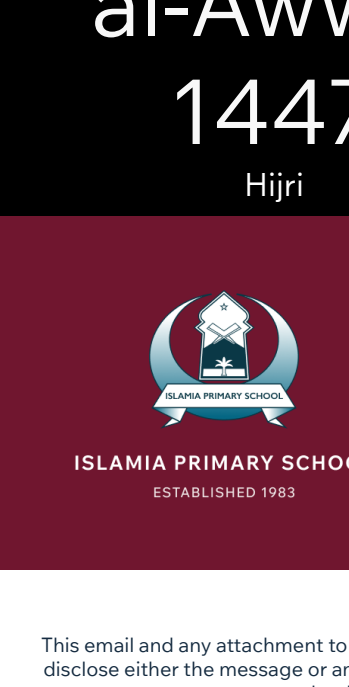

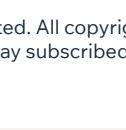
Be Respectful

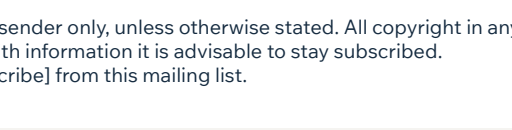
Jumuah Reminder
