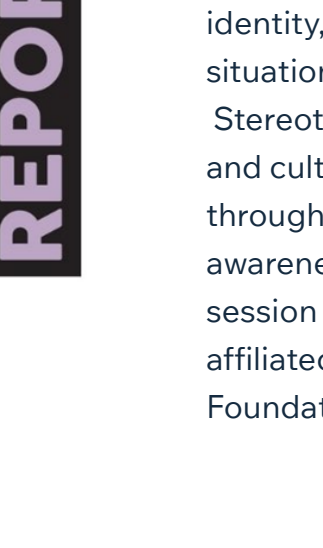
Our Seerah Week Exhibition

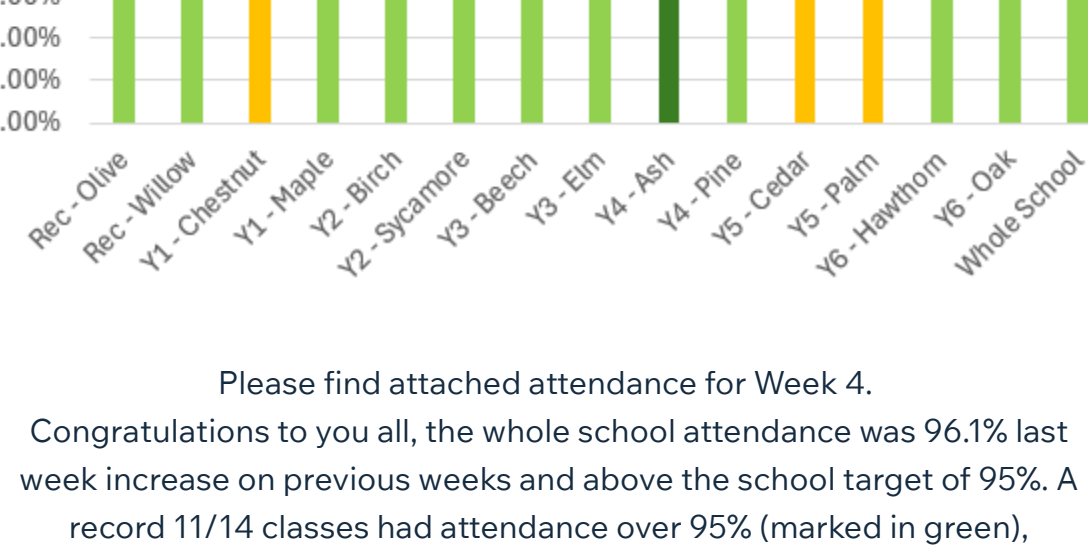
Pony Visits to Reception Year as part of Seerah Week Learning

KS2 Explore racism ...

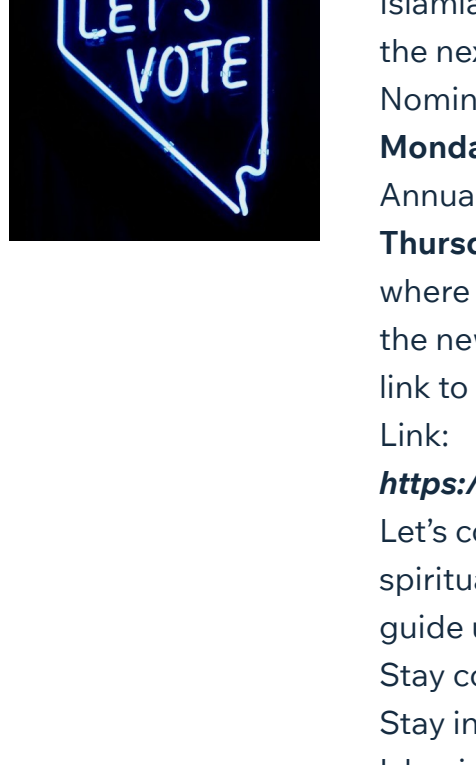

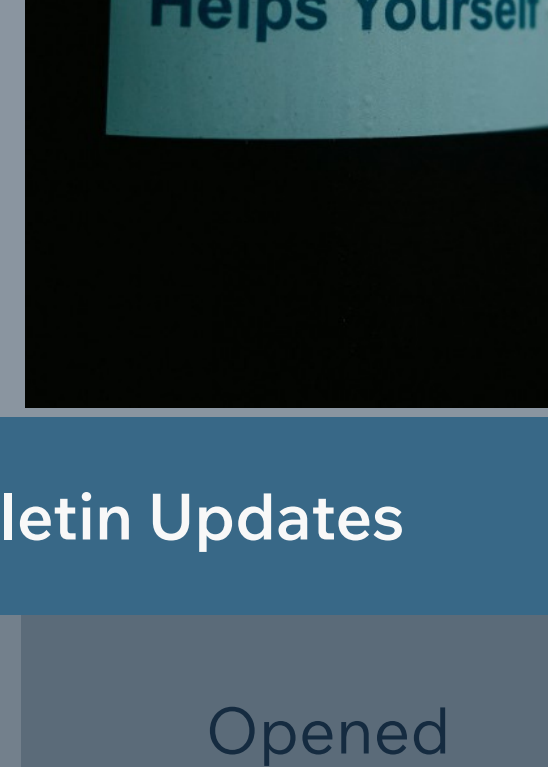
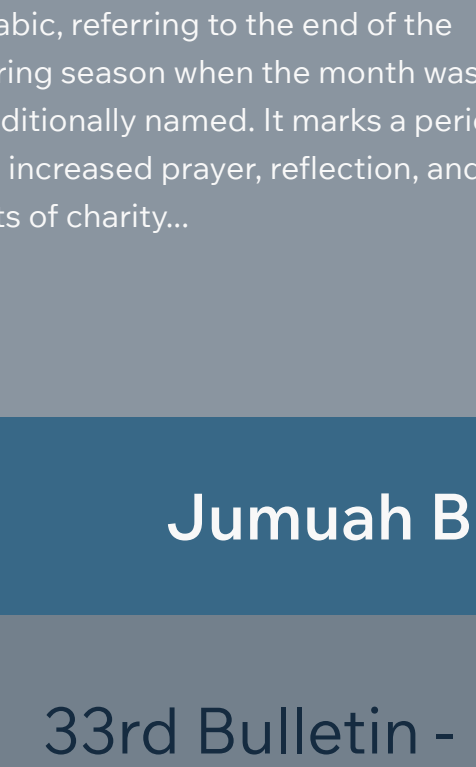
Attendance Aut 1 Week 4 (%)



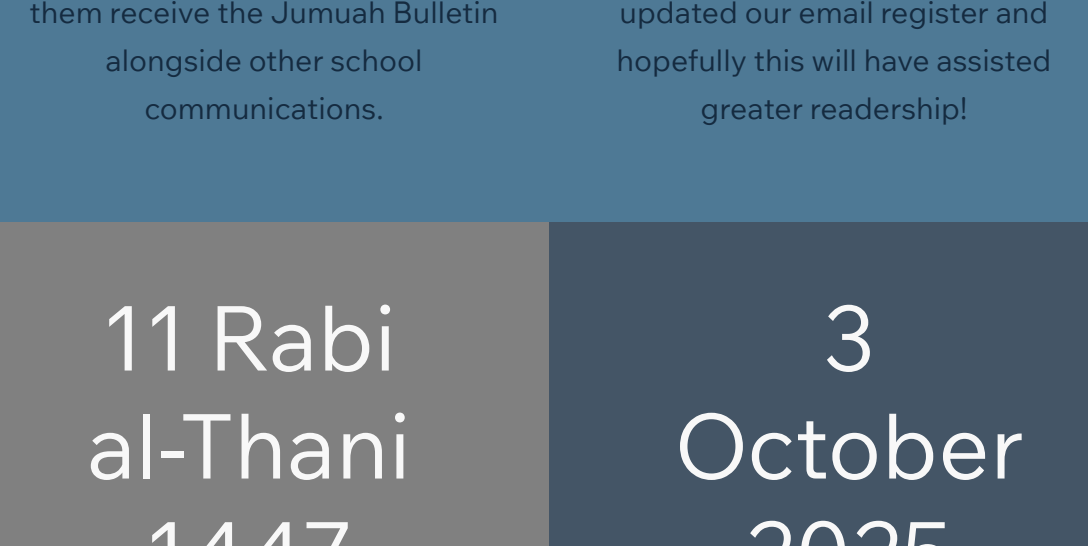

Thank you for your continued support in helping us maintain high standards for learning and achievement.

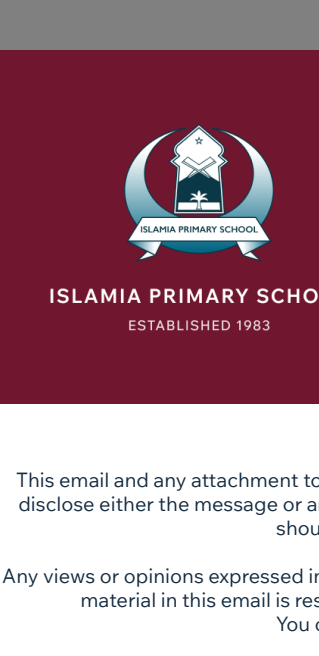

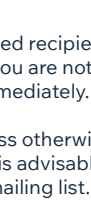
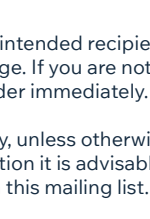
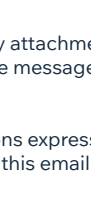
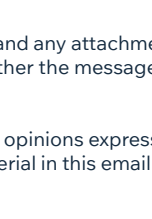
Islamia PSA Nominations Now Open!

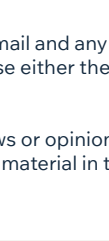

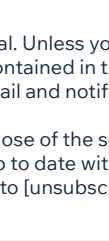

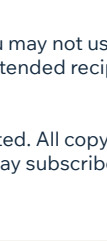
Be Respectful

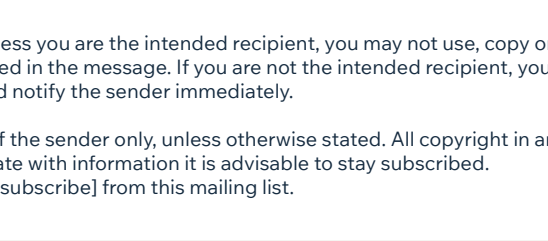


Be Punctual

Jumuah Reminder

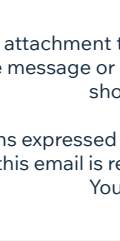
Rabi al Thani

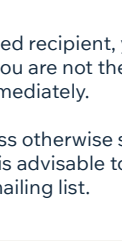

We have updated the entire school community contact details, this should hopefully successfully engage many more parents with updated details in order to help them receive the Jumuah Bulletin alongside other school communications.

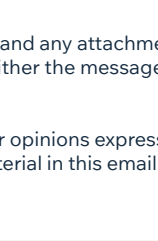
