Arabic: Children use a variety of activities to read and write the Arabic alphabets.

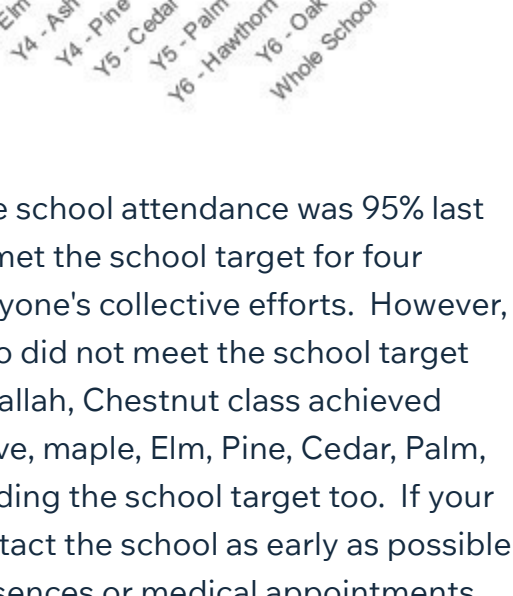


Student Council Update

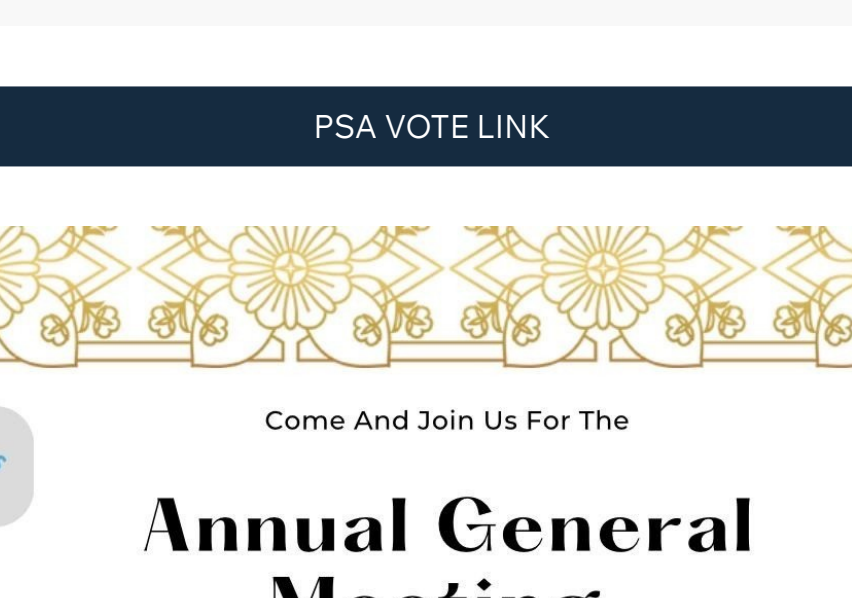

school closes today for half-term and resumes on Tuesday 4th November for students.



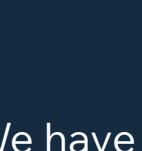
