Curriculum Corner

Design Technology...

Year 2: For their Design Technology unit on Structures

Year 2 class designed and constructed a chair for Baby Bear.



First they explored different types of structures using card and tape to identify stable and unstable structural shapes.

To create their chairs, the children rolled four pieces of card into tubes and taped them together to form sturdy legs. These supported the seat of the chair, which was made from thick rectangular card, along with a back rest to provide support for Baby Bear. They decorated the back rest and seat of the chair using coloured pens.

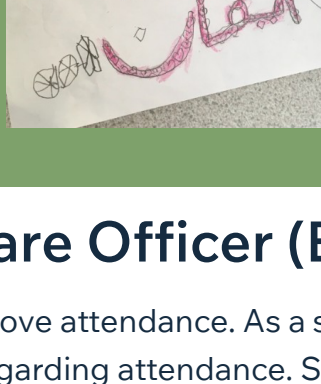
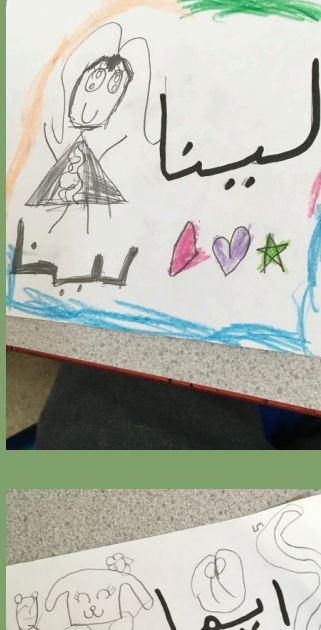
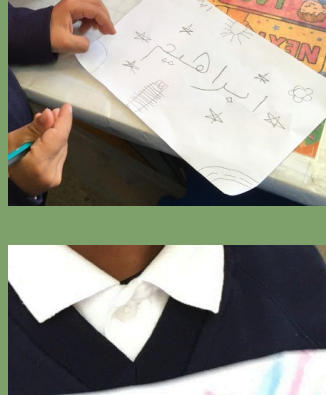
Key vocabulary words included,

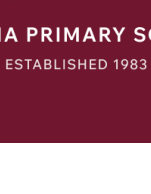
