Reception Eid Party:

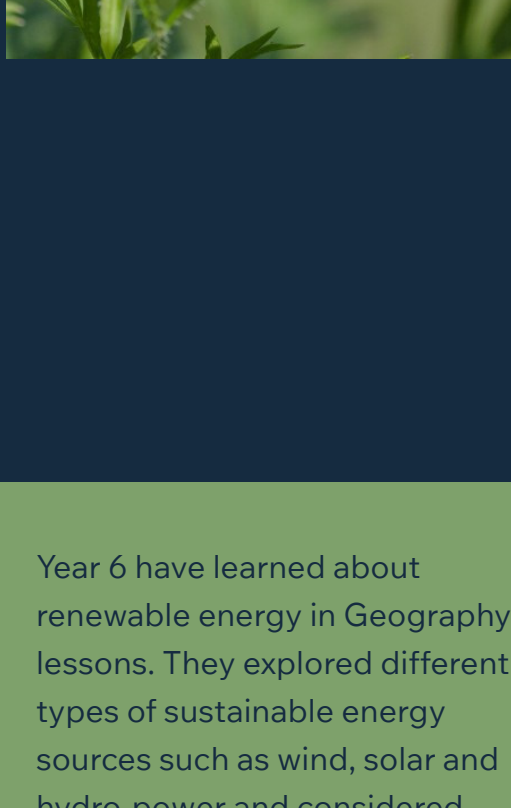
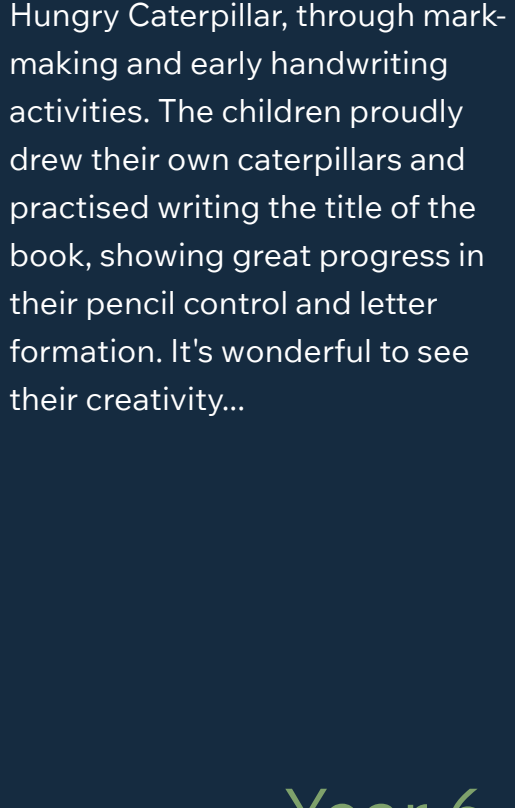
Reception had the best time celebrating Eid with their friends. Thank you to all the parents who so generously donated treats for the party.

Reception: The Very Hungry Caterpillar



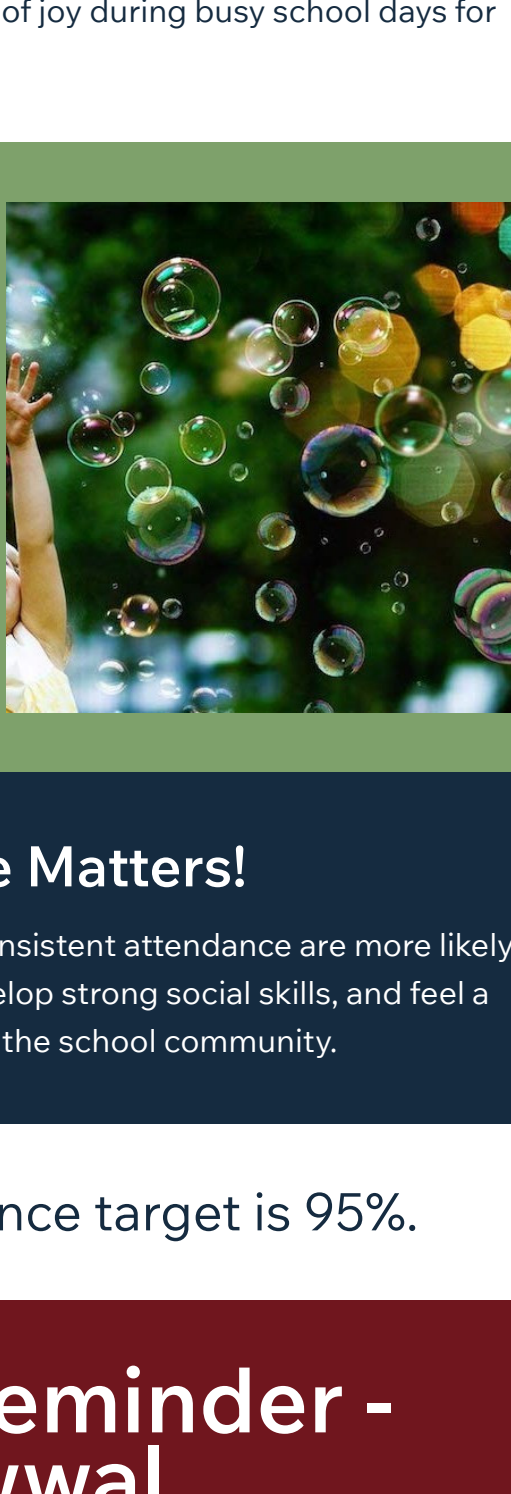
Year 6 Geography

Year 6 Geography

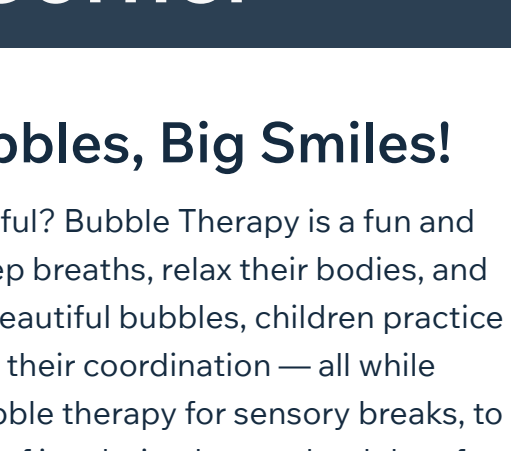
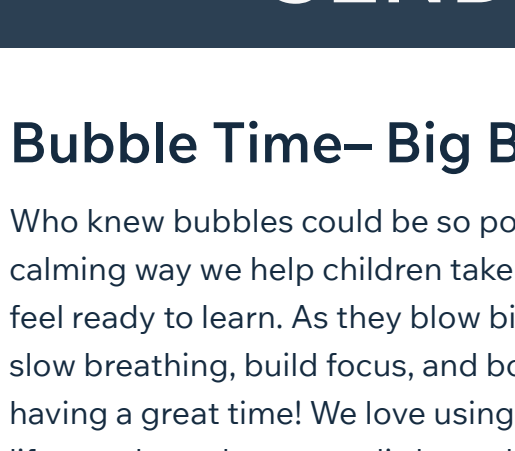

They explored different types of sustainable energy sources such as wind, solar and hydro-power and considered how these can help protect our planet. They also reflected on the importance of caring for the Earth as part of their Islamic faith, linking this knowledge to the concept of stewardship (Khaleefa).

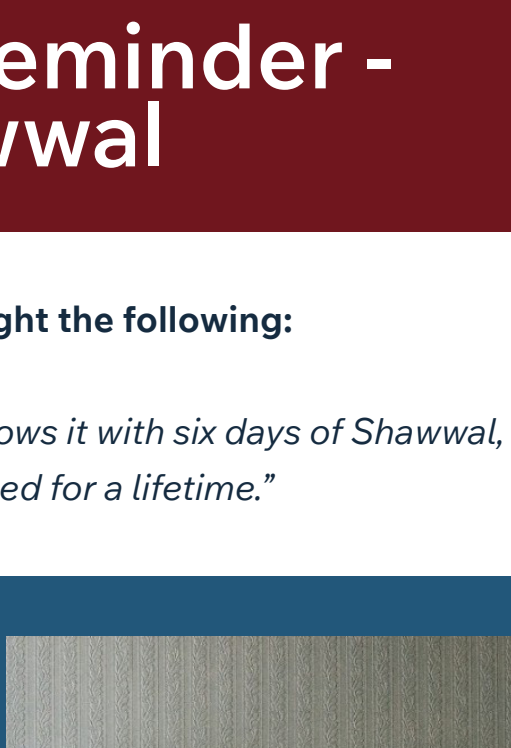
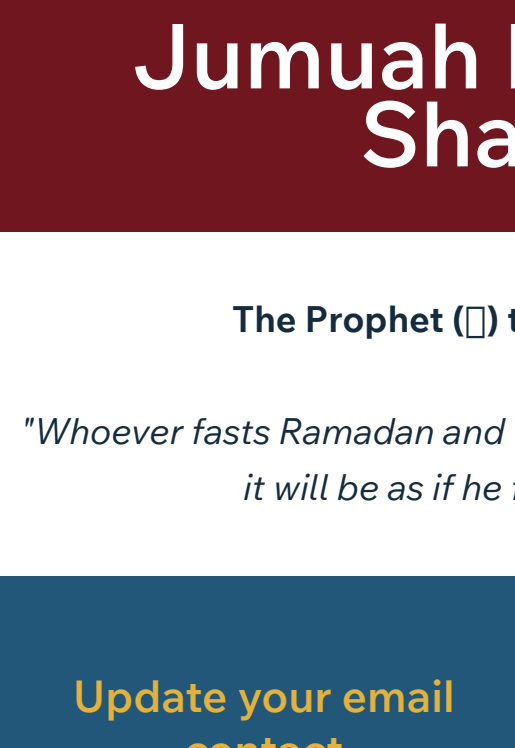

Jumuah Reminder - Shawwal

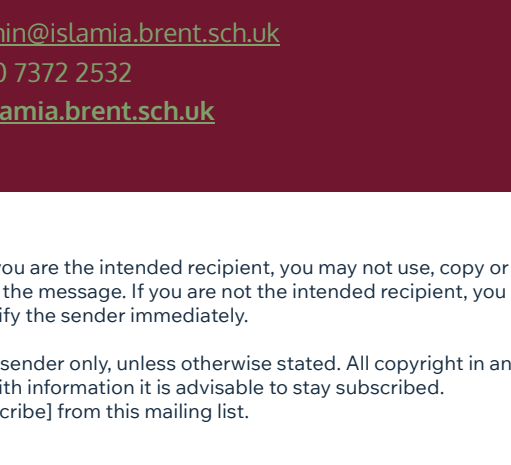
The Prophet (ﷺ) taught the following:
