Headteacher's Message

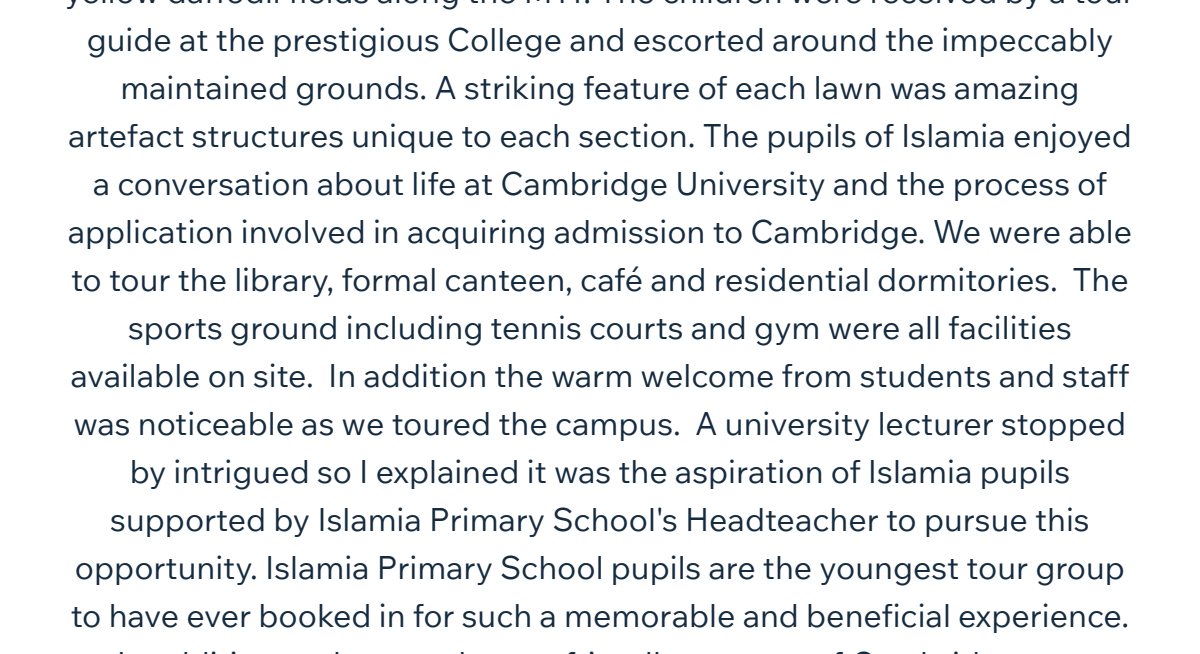

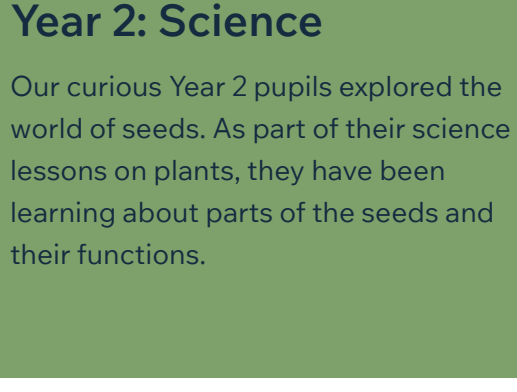
Ash Class participated in a 2 day Bike Course

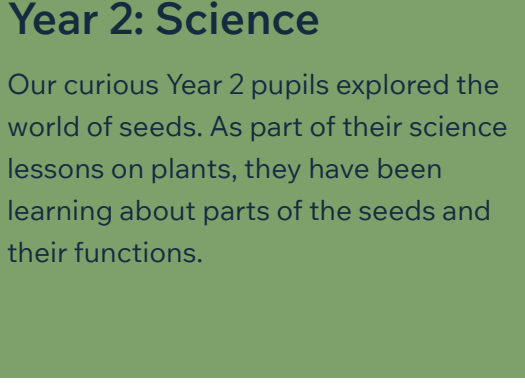

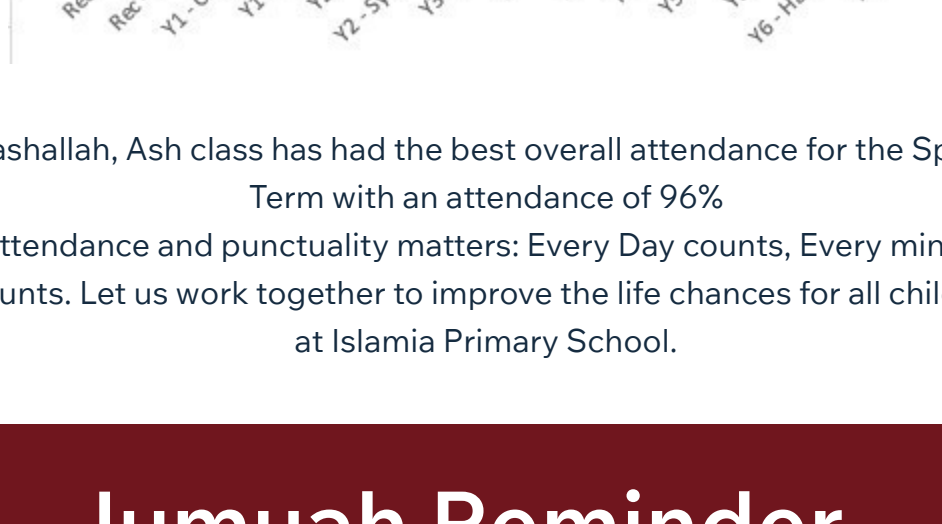
Bubble Time– Big Bubbles, Big Smiles!

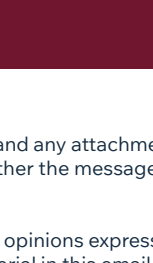
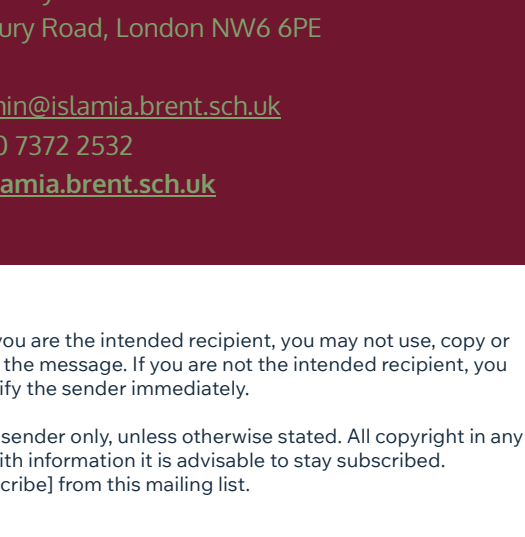
