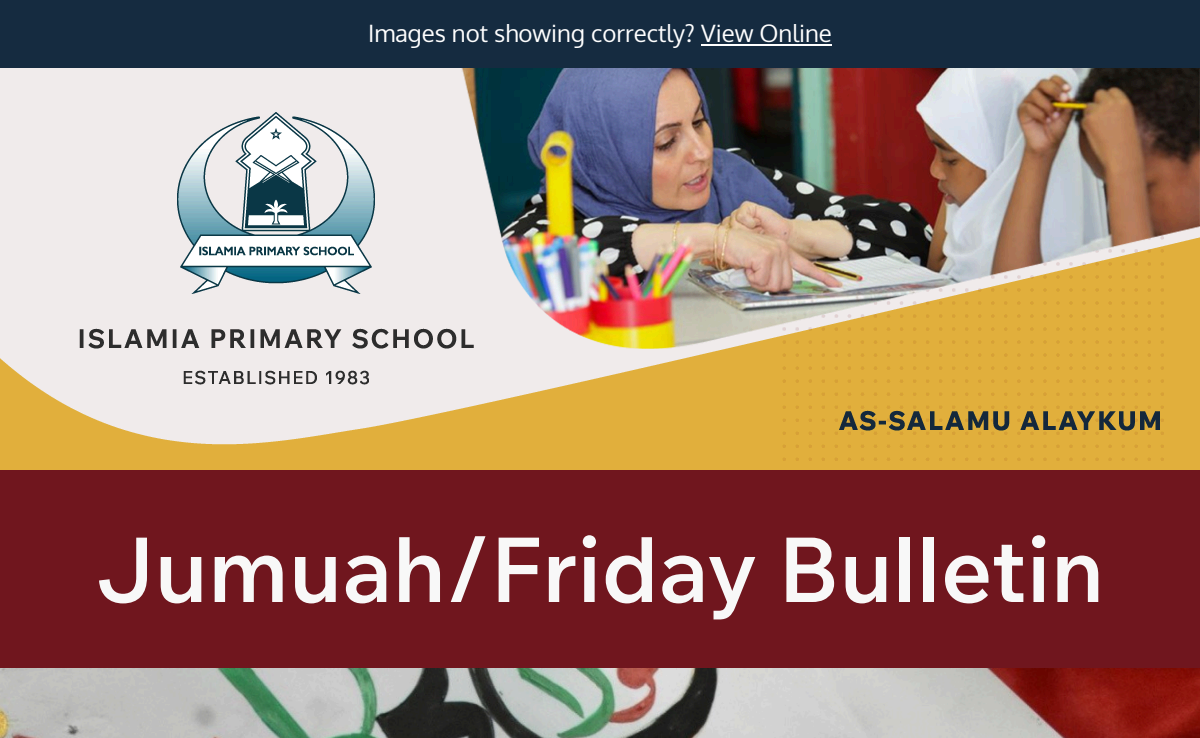

Curriculum Corner

Reception Year: Hajj 2025

Reception Year created their very own special airlines, Islamia Airlines, which took them on a special Hajj journey. Reception - The Naughty Bus & the 10-Frame Bus Activity

This week in Reception, our learning was centered around the exciting story The Naughty Bus!

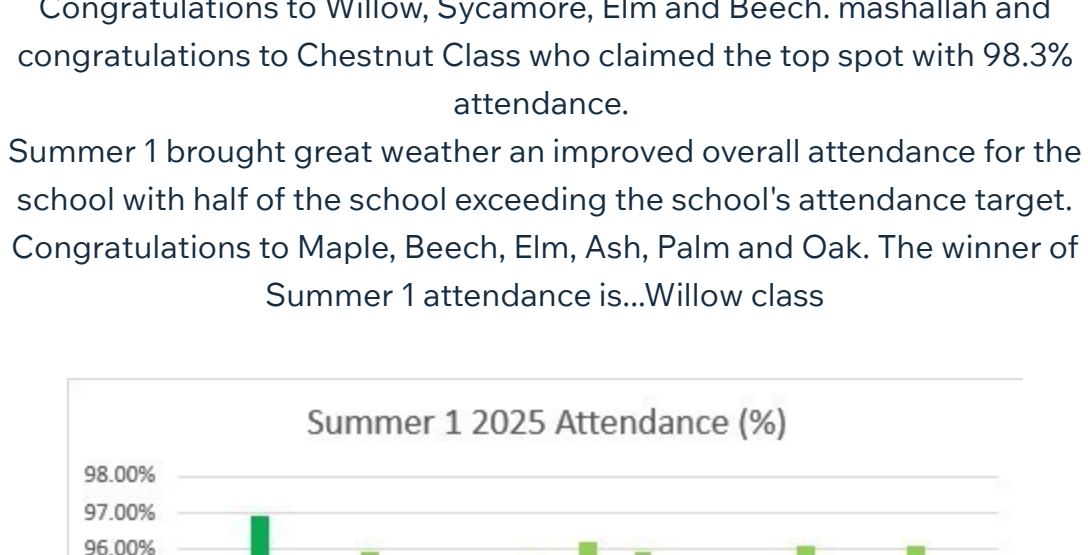
In Literacy, the children created story maps to help retell the story, and they used their imaginations to write sentences describing the Naughty Bus's adventures. They also designed wanted posters, using descriptive language to capture the bus's mischievous behaviour!

In Maths, we used a 10-frame bus activity to practise addition and subtraction. We also explored spatial reasoning through pattern recognition and used positional language to describe where things are and how they move.



Year 3 Get Creative with 3D Structures

This week in DT, the children in Year 3 (Beech and Elm) explored how to transform 2D shapes into imaginative 3D forms. Using a variety of construction techniques, and without the help of glue or tape, they were challenged to build freestanding structures from flat shapes. This hands-on, interactive activity sparked creativity and encouraged problem-solving, as pupils experimented with different ways to bring their designs to life. The children thoroughly enjoyed the challenge and demonstrated fantastic ingenuity throughout the session.



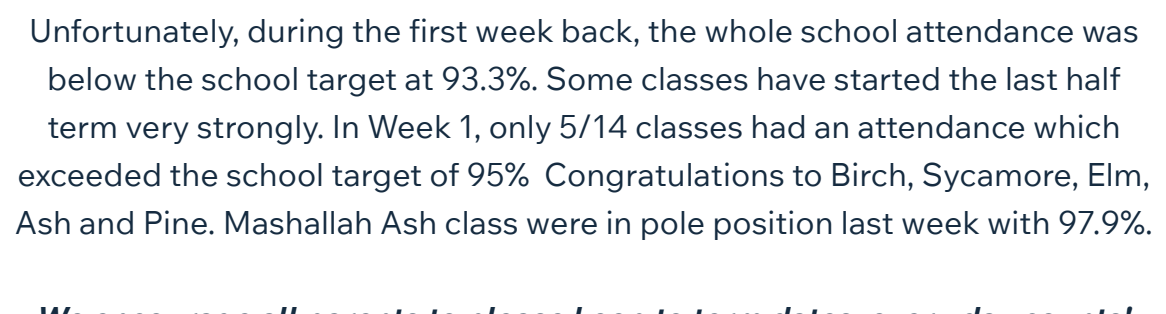
